Terms and conditions of entry

Submitting your entry

- A project or product may be submitted for up to three award categories if it meets the eligibility criteria for each category.
- There is no limit to the number of projects which can be entered by a single engineering organisation.
- An entry form must be submitted for each project or product entered.
- Confidential material should be clearly marked.
- Entries must be received by email to excellenceawards@engineersireland.ie by **2pm on Wednesday, 18 September 2019**.
- A fee of €250 per entry applies to each of the following categories:
 - Engineering Project of the Year
 - Geoscience Ireland Award
 - Local Authority Engineering Initiative Award
 - Heritage and Conservation Award
 - Engineering Education Award – Best in Class 2019
- We can only accept entries that are received with payment.
- Entry fees are non-refundable.

Judges and Judging

- Entries received after the published closing date will not be considered.
- The judging panel will determine the shortlist of entries once all entries are received.
- The decision of the judges is final and no correspondence concerning decisions will be entered into.
- Engineers Ireland reserves the right not to allocate an award should the quality of entries not reach a certain standard.
- Only one award trophy will be presented per winner in the case of joint/ group entries

Promotion

- Information about award winners will be strictly embargoed until the announcement at the presentation evening.
- Engineers Ireland reserves the right to publish in part or whole material contained in entries, apart from that clearly marked confidential.
- Entrants may be required to be available for award presentations and media interview
